

Disability Disaster Access & Resources (DDAR)

A program of CFLC (California Foundation for Independent Living Centers)

DDAR provides necessary resources to people with disabilities affected by the seasonal Public Safety Power Shutoff (PSPS) events.

The California Foundation for Independent Living Centers Disability Disaster Access and Resources (DDAR) program has learned that PG&E has initiated the first Public Safety Power Shutoff (PSPS) of the 2021 wildfire season.

Throughout the year, the California Disability Disaster Access and Resources program coordinates with nineteen local Independent Living Centers (ILCs)/Disability Disaster Access and Resource Centers (DDARCs) to deliver:

- Personal emergency preparedness support.
- Assistance with Medical Baseline and local emergency alert enrollment.
- Trainings on a series of disaster and related topics as well as assessing an individual's needs order to maintain their independence during a PSPS, or other disasters or emergencies.
- Additional assistance based on resources available.

How ready will you be if there is an emergency?

TIPS TO GET YOU PLANNING

When planning for an emergency:

- Write down a list of close contacts, who can check on you, include emergency contacts.
- Keep a list of medications in a zip lock bag to save it from getting wet or damaged.
- Collect emergency kit items over time, and make sure that the kit is personalized:
 - Save a school backpack or sturdy reusable shopping bag for your "to-go" items.
 - Keep an old pair of glasses in case your current pair of glasses get damaged or lost.
 - Save old travel size bottles for reuse of hygiene items (shampoos, sanitizers, lotions).
- Involve and share your plan with family, friends, caretakers keep them updated.
- Learn more about items for your emergency kit.

Preparing to be in different emergency scenarios:

Watch online videos for a variety of disasters depending on your area; If you would like PSPS informational video, please contact (661) 325-1063.



- Keep a variety of items in the "go-kit" from poncho to cooling rag.
- If traveling often, keep in mind the types of natural disasters that occur in those areas and create a small "to-go-kit"





- Know your exits in every space; observe and plan.
- Know what items will be needed that require electricity.




