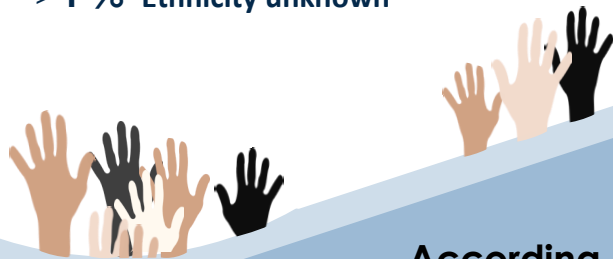


## Consumer Demographics

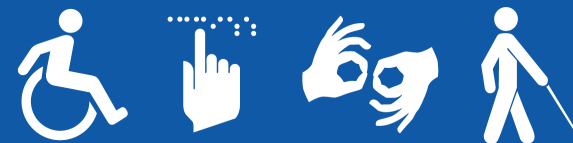

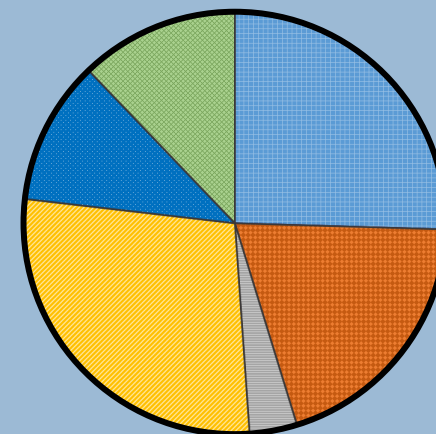

**431** Total Consumers

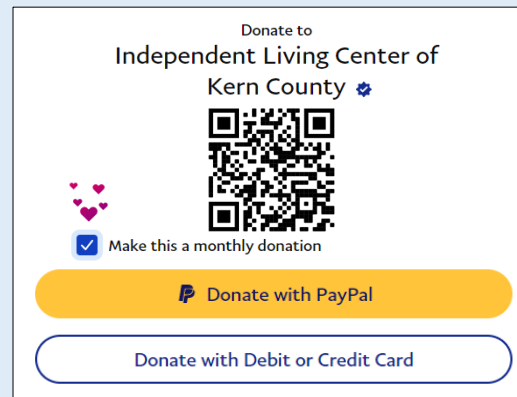
